**Planning Permission**

**Enactment:** Section 57 Town and Country Planning Act 1990

**Decision maker:** Central Bedfordshire Council

**Date of Application:** 14 February 2017

**Nature of Application:** Full planning permission for the construction of a 2.2km twin guideways passenger transit system between Luton Airport Parkway station and Luton Airport Central Terminal.

**Application Reference:** CB/17/00716/OUT

**Status:** Granted on 7 July 2017

**Planning Permission**

**Enactment:** Section 57 Town and Country Planning Act 1990

**Decision maker:** Luton Borough Council

**Date of Application:** 14 February 2017

**Nature of Application:** Full planning permission for the construction of a 2.2km twin guideways mass passenger transit system between Luton Airport Parkway station and Luton Airport Central Terminal.

**Application Reference:** 17/00283/FUL

**Status:** Granted on 30 June 2017

**Stage 1 approval under the Cableway Installations Regulations 2018**

**Enactment:** Cableway Installations Regulations 2018

**Decision maker:** Secretary of State for Transport

**Nature of Application:** Stage 1 approval from the Secretary of State for Transport under regulations 8(1) and 13 of the Cableway Installations Regulations 2018 to commence building any cableway.

**Application Reference:** 181031

**Status:** Granted on 24 October 2019

**Stage 2 approval under the Cableway Installations Regulation 2018**

**Enactment:** Cableway installations Regulations 2018

**Decision maker:** Secretary of State for Transport

**Nature of Application:** The Applicant is obliged by regulations 6(1), 8(3) and 14 of the Cableways Installations Regulations 2018 to obtain stage 2 approval from the Secretary of State for Transport to bring any cableway installation into service. The Applicant will be required to submit a technical file and the relevant fee when making this application.

**Application Reference:** Not applicable

**Status:** Stage 2 approval cannot be sought until after the construction of the passenger transit system has been completed. Stage 2 approval will authorise the passenger transit system to be brought into service once it has been tested and shown to be safe for passenger use.

**Temporary Stopping up of Highway**

**Enactment:** Section 14 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

**Decision Maker:** Luton Borough Council

**Nature of Application:** Submission of a request to Luton Borough Council to exercise its powers as a traffic authority to temporarily stop up the A1081 in order to allow the construction of a gateway bridge above it.

**Status:** Luton Borough Council made two orders dated 1 February 2019 and 7 October 2019 respectively to temporarily close the A1081 to traffic. The orders will lapse on 27 January 2020 and 2 October 2020 respectively.

**Licence to Oversail the Highway**

**Enactment:** Section 176 Highways Act 1980

**Decision Maker:** Luton Borough Council

**Nature of Application:** Application pursuant to section 176 Highways Act 1980 to construct a bridge oversailing the A1081.

**Status:** Luton Borough Council, acting in its capacity as the Highway Authority for the A1081, granted a licence dated 29 November 2019 under section 176 Highways Act 1980 to LLAL to construct a gateway bridge to carry the passenger transit system over the road.
